



## Checklist for DUI License Reinstatement

### When Can I Reinstatement?

- If you took a chemical test and were revoked, then after 30 days of no driving, you may reinstate with an interlock
- If you refused to take a test, then after 60 days of no driving, you may reinstate with an interlock

### How to Reinstatement

In order to reinstate you must complete and submit the following to the DMV at 1881 Pierce Street, Lakewood, CO 80214:

- After installation of an Ignition Interlock system in every vehicle you own or drive, submit Installation Certificates for each car
  - Complete and have notarized the Restricted License Ignition Interlock Agreement Affidavit, Form # [DR 2058](#)
  - Complete the Application for Reinstatement, Form # [DR 2870](#)
  - Submit \$95, check or money order made out to the Department of Revenue
  - Provide SR22 Insurance, must be maintained for 9 months after reinstatement or for 3 years if there was an accident or your BAC was .15 or higher (regardless of an accident)
  - Submit compliance with alcohol and drug education
    - **If your BAC was < .150**, Complete an Alcohol/Drug Certification, Form # [DR 2598](#)
- OR
- **If your BAC was >.150**, Complete the Affidavit of Enrollment Form # [DR 2643](#)
- OR
- Submit a Discharge Referral Summary (DRS) from your treatment provider

About 2-3 weeks after submitting all your paperwork and forms, you will be sent a Letter of Clearance. Take the Letter of Clearance to any full-service DMV to reinstate your driving privileges. The DMV may require a written and/or driving test at their discretion.

**Only when you have your new license in your possession are you valid to drive.**
